

## Baseball Cake Cap - By Doris Kenfield

1. The first thing you need to do is cover a baseball cap with plastic wrap.



2. Cut a pattern of the bill from a cap and trace it onto rolled gum paste



3. With a tracing wheel, make the stitching on the cap.



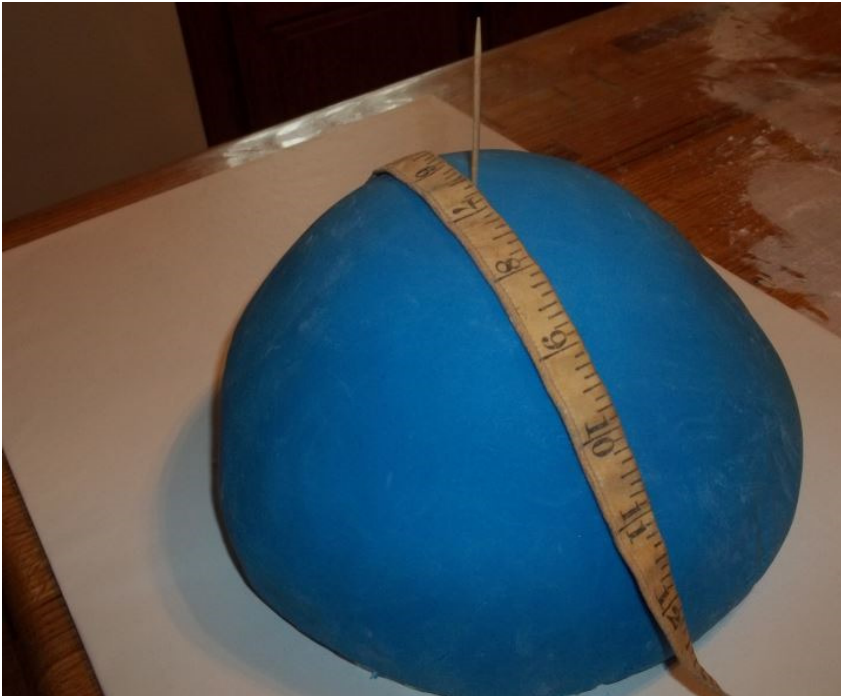
4. Place the stitched piece of gumpaste on the bill of the hat that is covered with plastic and let it dry for 1-2 days. This will serve as the former for the paste.



5. Bake a 7", 6", and a half dome cake. Stack and frost them.



6. Cover it with fondant, the color is your choice. Then find the center and mark it with a toothpick.





7. Mark 6 sections evenly, I mark them with pencil from the bottom to the center, lead is edible. (Side note, it's non-toxic, but if you are not comfortable using pencil, just score the lines in the fondant.)



8. With the smooth attachment on the tracing wheel, mark the seams. Note, be careful not to press too hard, you will cut through the fondant, but hard enough to make the imprint. Then use the tracing wheel to mark the stitching on both sides of the seam. Now you are ready to attach the bill, the logo of your choice, and the button on top.



9. When everything is dry, I steam the whole cake. It takes all of the cornstarch marks off and makes it look more professional.
