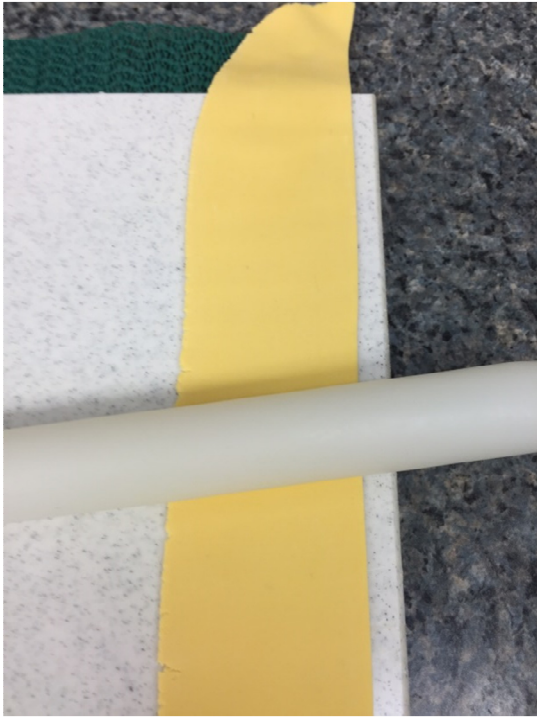


## Another Method of Using Tappits –

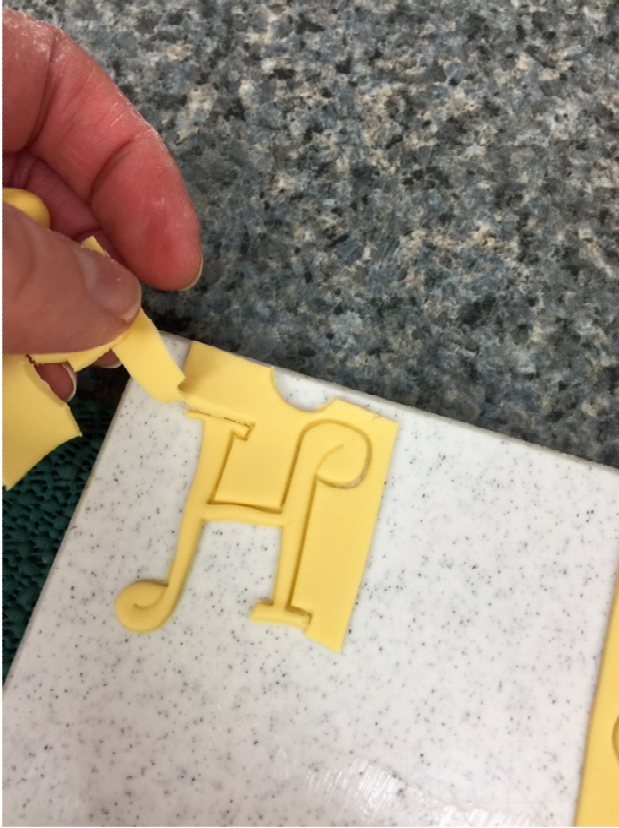
This method is different than the instructions in the package. I really like doing them this way. Customers often convey to me that they have difficulty using the Tappits, so hopefully you will try this method. It's super easy. 😊

1-2 L - I like to use a Cel Board but I imagine a Sil-Pat mat would work just as well, or any hard surface like a counter. Lightly grease your surface with vegetable shortening. You can use gumpaste or fondant. R –I put the paste through my KA gumpaste roller (LOVE that BTW) on #1. Roll a nice long strip.

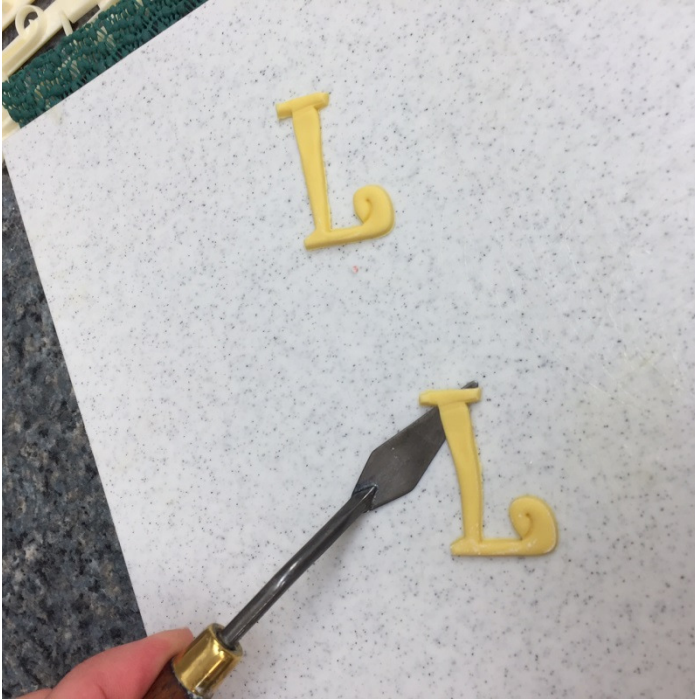




3-4 L – Gently roll down the strip of paste to stick it to the board/grease. R - Taking the letter you need, press down on the paste. I wiggle it EVER SO slightly. If you get any sticking you can take a cornstarch puff and dust the cutter first. Make a cut so the letter has it's own little square.



5-6 L – Let the letter dry just a bit, then pull the excess away from the outside of each letter. Using a pin, you can pop out the middle parts if that applies. R – Then leave the letters to dry completely. (This set is the Funky Letters Capitol and Numbers.)



7 – Once dry, just take a thin palette knife and gently remove them from the board. Apply to your cake. Piece of cake! Jen 😊
