

How to make a cute little JEM high heel shoe

1. L – I'm using the JEM ladies high heel shoe set to make this little shoe. The parts included in the kit are as shown in the left picture. R – First I'm going to make the heel. I'm mixing a tiny bit of tylose into a small amount of black fondant.



2. L – Make a cone like shape, dust mold and sandwich between the two pieces.



3. I took my palette knife and leveled off the top edge of the paste. Don't worry about any excess seams, we can trim them once it dries. Let dry at least overnight on some soft foam.



4. L - Trim any excess seams with an Xacto knife. R – The heel will go up against the white foam to attach the sole paste as shown.



5. L - Place some gumglue on the top/flat end of the dried heel. R - Again, I mixed some Tylose into some black fondant. Roll it out and cut a sole shape using the sole cutter. Make the paste about as thick as the cutter, then the little stitch impressions will go into the paste.



6. L – Using the foam former in the set, place the sole paste over the former and attach to the glued heel. R – Take the toe strap cutter and cut a piece of paste to form the toe piece.



7. L – Form the toe piece over the little foam provided to let it firm a bit. Cut a back and ankle strap. R – Let the straps sit a bit until they are firmer, then attach the back, straight strap first using gumglue.



8 – L – Apply gumglue to the toe strap and apply to the sole, add the second ankle strap. Prop with tissue for a bit if they want to move.



9 – To remove any cornstarch, I ran the airbrush with vodka in it. White marks gone 😊 I made a simple bow and added some dragees. But you can do any kind of decoration on your shoe.
