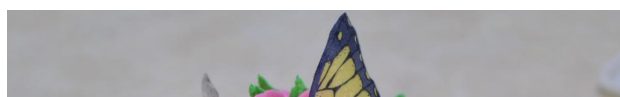


Step 6 Fill in the flower pot top with green icing and make a mound. (If you are using a different flower for the top and would like to see dirt, use chocolate icing and crushed oreos for the dirt.) Place the cut out flowers into the icing making sure to fill in as much space as possible. Start at the bottom and work your way around and up.

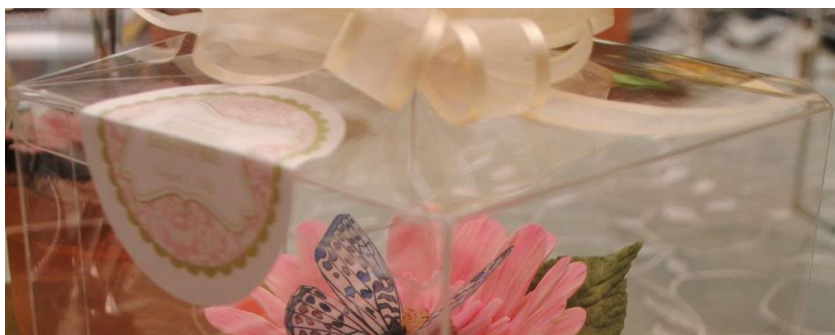


Step 7 Finish off by piping green leaves into any gaps that are showing. Pipe flower centers in the middle of the flowers. Top off with a wafer paper butterfly.
